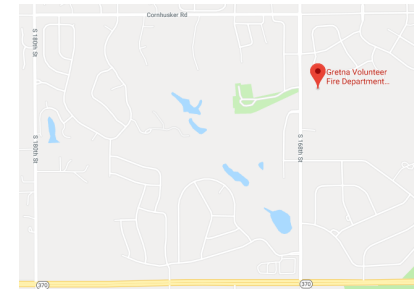
The course offers lectures, graphics, videos and practice questions in many of the areas that are tested on the CEN exam. This review provides a foundation for further study as the participant works toward certification.
